Our Vision

We envision a world where children are safe and families transformed through radically compassionate communities.

Our Mission

Safe Families for Children hosts vulnerable children and creates extended family–like supports for desperate families through a community of devoted volunteers who are motivated by compassion to keep children safe and families intact.

Founded in Chicago in 2003, Safe Families for Children (SFFC) is a multi-site volunteer movement that gives hope and support to families in distress. SFFC reframes how families are supported during a crisis. Parents voluntarily place their children in safe, loving homes where they are cared for while other volunteers wrap around and support the parent to help them get back on their feet and restore stability in their lives. SFFC is dedicated to family support, stabilization and, most importantly, child abuse prevention.

Our Objectives

The three objectives of Safe Families for Children are:

1. Keep children safe during a family crisis such as homelessness, hospitalization, or domestic violence in an effort to prevent child abuse and/or neglect.

2. Support and stabilize families in crisis by surrounding them with caring, compassionate community.

3. Reunite families and reduce the number of children entering the child welfare system.



Planted and Growing

Since our first chapter started in Chicago 15 years ago, we are now present in hundreds of cities represented by 108 chapters. It has been through many fruitful partnerships with like-minded nonprofits that we've been able to surround families in crisis from Maine to California and Florida to Oregon.





The Safe Families for Children Model



Parents in need voluntarily approach SFFC through a selfreferral or other referral sources. They can opt to reunify with their children at any time and never lose custody of their children.

Family in Crisis

Host families are recruited on an ongoing basis and undergo an application and screening process (background check, home study, references).



Family Friends support parents in need by befriending, coaching, and offering moral support until their situation has begun to normalize, thus helping them to improve their parenting and home environment.

Family Coach

Throughout the hosting arrangement, Family Coaches offer emotional and tangible support to families in need and host families. The family coaches work with parents in crisis to develop goals and visit the host families' homes regularly to offer guidance and support.

Safe Families for Children is a 501(c) (3) not-for-profit organization. We operate a number of chapters and also partner with other nonprofit organizations to provide hope and support to families in the local communities that are served. Making Waves



Legislation

We have found it necessary to pass legislation in a number of states. In partnership with Foundation for Government Accountability, legislation has passed in the following states: **Texas**, **Arkansas**, **Washington**, **Oregon**, **Alaska**, **Kansas**, **Oklahoma**, **Mississippi**, **Wisconsin**, **Indiana**, **Kentucky**, **West Virginia**, **Virginia**, **Maine**, and **Georgia**.

Internationally

The Safe Families movement has exploded in the United Kingdom. Safe Families UK recently won the national award for Innovative Quality Outcomes Award from the 3rd Sector Care Awards. Safe Families UK is funded by over 28 local governments and has helped 4,800 children and 2,000 families since its founding in 2013. They work in over 40 cities throughout Scotland, Wales, and England. Their network includes 3,400 volunteers and 645 churches across the UK.



The Road Ahead

Replicating Our Model

Safe Families has begun to attract other organizations who are interested in preventing child abuse and keeping kids out of the foster care system. Many are referring to their programs as "Safe Families-like".

Establishing Safe Families as an Evidenced-Based Practice

Most parents may appreciate knowing that they are being helped by a movement that has underwent rigorous evaluations to determine how effective it is. That is why we entered into an agreement with DCFS Illinois and Dr. Mark Testa from the University of North Carolina to assess our impact via the highest level of research, a randomized control evaluation. DCFS in Illinois is randomizing families during the investigation to Safe Families and "business as usual." We look forward to the outcome of this evaluation.

Tackling Legislation Challenges

There are a number of legislative challenges that we are currently tackling. We are working with state lawmakers in New York, Colorado, Michigan, and Iowa to pass laws to enable Safe Families to prevent children from entering foster care and keeping families intact.

Engaging Social Investors through Pay For Success

This year, Safe Families won a national competition to establish Pay for Success funding in the US. Pay for Success is an innovative funding tool that leverages social investors (those wanting to use their wealth for social change) with an ability to earn a rate of return on their investment from local and federal governments. We have been meeting with six different states who've expressed an interest in this initiative.
